

Search Tools

- Quotation Marks
 "James Wilson" or "Wilson, James". Limits your results to what you want.
- Use the Minus Sign
 Tells the search what NOT to look for. James Wilson New York – Vermont
- Get Site Specific Results
 Use site: URL address before a term or terms to search your target only from a specific site. site:familysearch.org"James Wilson" New York Vermont

Search Tools

- Search Only Page Titles
 To make sure a search term appears in the title page of a document. allintitle: "James Wilson"
- Search A Date Range
 Lets you seach <u>multiple</u> dates without entering them individually.
- "James Wilson" 1800..1856-1857. The *NOT* stops the search past the dates you want.

Search Tools

Search For Terms Near Each Other
 Around (a number)
 "James Wilson" Around (10)1840 Will search for pages where
 James Wilson appears within 10 words of the date 1840
